Pastor's Corner "I ord We Wait for You"

The Apple Music app has a feature where it recommends songs or albums its algorithms calculate that I will appreciate. Most of the time it's wrong, particularly where worship music is concerned. This morning, however, it introduced me to a song called, "Advent 1: Hallelujah! Christ Is Coming" by the crossgenerational poet-musician duo Liturgical Folk. (I assure you the fact they are Texans is entirely coincidental.) (Really.) (But I admit I'm "tickled," as my Texan dad would say.) I'm sharing the lyrics with you below because I think they declare with simplicity the heart of our theme this Advent, "What are you waiting for?" We are waiting for Jesus to come.
